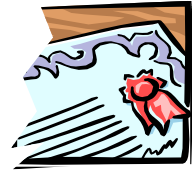
The school was included in the latest batch of school zone sites to receive the flashing lights. The project aims to alert motorists of the speed restriction around schools in order to improve safety for school children.
