- ✎ Make sure your children have taken time to eat and drink before the performance.

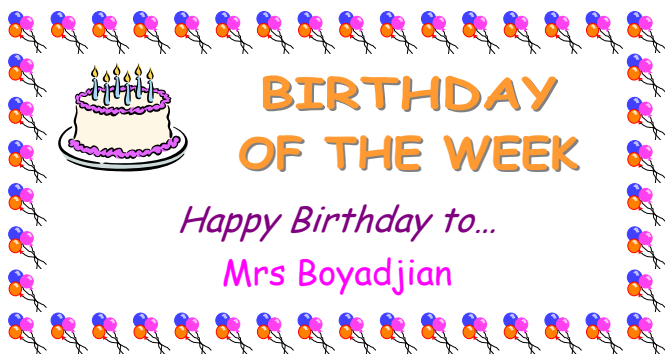


### REMINDER: Don't Forget the Fruit!
