GROWTH IN OUR LEARNING RESOURCES

In our 'Year of Growth' we have also increased the use of our online learning resources. Since the installation of the Interactive Whiteboards (IWB) in each of our classrooms, they have become an integral part of our teaching and learning. These have been complemented with individualised student laptop and classroom computers that have brought the world of education to the forefront of our classrooms, greatly benefiting the learning resources now available at our fingertips.



While these resources have been utilised in our classrooms with the support of educational software, we know that they can also be implemented at home, as they are all 'cloud' based programs. These programs can easily be accessed by our students to supplement their learning.
