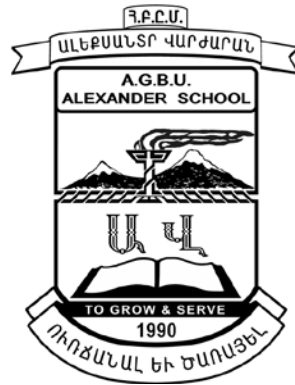

UNIFORM POLICY

UNIFORM DRESS CODE

Each student represents AGBU Alexander Primary School when dressed in school uniform. The appearance and presentation of students reflect directly on the image of our school so good grooming must be encouraged by parents and staff on a daily basis.

All items of the school uniform, other than footwear and hair accessories, are available from the school. Uniforms may be purchased in the following ways:

- Attendance at specified uniform days
- Telephoning order to the office
- Written order to the office

Uniforms will not be supplied to students unless confirmation of purchase is made by a parent in writing or verbally.

Students are expected to wear correct uniform at all times. Staff will ensure students are made aware of incorrect dress or poor grooming. Each week a uniform check is randomly conducted at school to ensure correct uniform and labelling of clothes. Students are rewarded for adherence.

Parents are expected to maintain all school apparel so that uniforms are clean, ironed/pressed and mended daily.

The school uniform must be worn as follows:

Girls Uniform:

Summer: Grey chequered tunic
Grey ankle socks with blue and yellow stripes
Navy blue hat with school emblem

Sports: Navy blue pleated skirt / skort
Navy sports briefs
Yellow polo shirt with school emblem
White ankle socks (covers ankle)
Navy blue tracksuit jumper with school emblem (if cold)

Winter: Grey chequered pinafore
Yellow long-sleeved shirt with Peter Pan collar
Blue ribbon tie
Navy blue V-necked woollen jumper with school emblem
Grey tights
Navy blue hat with school emblem

Sports: Navy blue tracksuit with school emblem
Yellow skivvy
White ankle socks

Boys Uniform:

- Summer:** Grey shorts (elasticised/buckled)
Yellow short-sleeved shirt
Navy blue school tie with emblem
Grey knee-high socks with blue and yellow stripes
Navy blue school cap with school emblem
- Sports:** Navy blue shorts
Yellow polo shirt with school emblem
White ankle socks
Navy blue tracksuit jumper with school emblem (if cold)
- Winter:** Grey trousers
Yellow long-sleeved shirt
Navy blue school tie with emblem
Navy blue V-necked jumper with school emblem
Grey knee-high socks with blue and yellow stripes
Navy cap with school emblem
- Sports:** Navy blue tracksuit with school emblem
Yellow skivvy
White ankle socks

General Uniform:

- Shoes - Black lace-up/buckled school shoes (not available from school)
Sport Shoes - White sports shoes with white laces (not available from school)
School Bag - Crested school bag
Raincoat - Yellow or navy blue (not available from school)

Labelling

All removable clothing should be clearly marked with student's name.

Lost Property

The school office holds a lost property bin. Parents and/or students must identify lost property personally before it may be handed over.

School Shirts / Blouses

Shirts, blouses and skivvies must always be neatly tucked into trousers and other apparel. Shirt collars should be buttoned at the neck. Boys must wear school ties in correct form.

School Jumper -vs- Sports Jumper

Students must only wear sports jumper (tracksuit top) with sports uniform on sports days. At all other times, students must wear crested woollen jumper.

School Headgear

School caps and hats are an essential part of the uniform. Headgear must be worn travelling to and from school and in the playground at all times.

Footwear

Boys must wear proper lace-up (or Velcro) black school shoes. Girls are permitted to wear buckled black school shoes. Black shoes should be polished and clean at all times. Sports shoes must be white leather or canvas lace-ups. Unless otherwise requested by a class teacher, sports shoes should be brought to school for fitness and only worn to school on sports days.

Students must ensure shoe laces are tied at all times for reasons of safety and well-grooming. On non-sport days, students must travel to and from school in black school shoes.

Hair & Accessories

Boys hair should be kept short. Girls hair should be combed back or tied back with navy blue ribbon. Headbands and other hair accessories are only permitted in navy blue.

Jewellery / Watches

Jewellery must not be worn to school. Girls with pierced ears may only wear gold stud earrings.

Watches should only be worn by upper grade students in Years 3 to 6. Analog watches are preferred to digital. Digital watches with equipped alarms are not permitted.

DISCIPLINARY MEASURES

Students who do not adhere to this Code will be subject to the following disciplinary measures:

Lost Article

A student who loses an article of uniform will require a note from his/her parents. He/She will be given one week's grace to find the lost article. On notification, the school will assist in seeking the lost property. However, parents will need to purchase a replacement if the article is not found after this period.

Should a woollen school jumper be lost, the student may wear the school sports jumper for the week of grace *but* will still require a note from parents.

Incorrect Uniform

Students who wear incorrect uniform or do not bring sports shoes daily for fitness will receive a penalty. Four penalties during a two week period will result in a detention. Two concurrent detentions will result in a drop of behaviour level.
